

## 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Lesson 3: Your Turn to Write a Biography

### Intro

- Students should share any other biographies they have read, through Tales2Go or in a physical book
- Review the features of a biography

### Listen and Research

- Each student should choose a person to research and write a biography about
- Students may or may not find the person they are researching through audio books, so check out books from your school or local library
- After they choose, use the **Scholastic Biography Organizer** to write all the information they find

### Respond

- Students should first write their draft, then go through the writing process—edit and make a final draft
- When students are ready, allow them to record their biography on a device with a microphone and speakers

### Wrap up

- Students can have a “biography day” and listen to each other’s biographies, just like they do with audio books
