Then write a paragraph for a newspaper article including these facts. • Create a "book jacket" for the title including a picture on the front, along with a summary inside of the cover and a review on the back • Compare this title with another fiction title you have read or listened to recently • Write a different ending to the audiobook • Draw 3 scenes from the audiobook • Write a different solution to the problem in the audiobook • Design a poster advertising the audiobook • Write a 4-5 sentence summary of the audiobook • List the most important events in order • Write about a time something similar happened to you • Paraphrase the selection • List 3 new words and look them up in a dictionary • Make up a new title for the audiobook
